

EXAMPLE OF MASK EXEMPTION

Statutory Declaration

OATHS ACT 1900, NSW, NINTH SCHEDULE

I, Janice Campbell, of 27 Wallaby Lane, Sydney, NSW 2055

do hereby solemnly declare and affirm that I suffer from acute sinusitis.

The present directives that have created a mandate for wearing a mask cannot be satisfied by myself, and there are no reasonable adjustments that can be made to satisfy same.

I do not present any Covid-19 symptoms.

I make this solemn declaration, as to the matter aforesaid, according to the law in this behalf made – and subject to the punishment by law provided for any wilfully false statement in any such declaration.
